



MISSISSIPPI STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH

The Mississippi State Department of Health, Central Public Health Region, is seeking to fill the Licensed Nurse Practical (LPN) vacancy at Sunflower County Health Department. This first-level nursing position is accountable for administering medication and other prescribed treatments, taking vital signs, assisting with care plan activities, observing, and reporting patient conditions and behaviors, and participating in rehabilitation, ambulation, and transfers. The LPN communicates with doctors, patients, and families, and educates patients on care.

The County Licensed Nurse Practical (LPN) will assist with public health nursing services primarily within a county health department clinic under the direction of a County Coordinating Nurse. Duties include conducting patient assessments, developing treatment plans, providing health education, referring patients to care, conducting disease control activities, performing direct patient care procedures, home visitation, and serving on emergency/disaster response teams.
