





CHANGES IN STATE LAW

Legislative Update for the 2020 Mississippi Legislative Session

HOUSE BILL 94. Signed 06/29/2020. Effective 07/01/2020.

An act to establish the Mississippi Center for Rural Health Innovation within the Office of Rural Health of the State Department of Health for the purpose to provide services and resources to rural hospitals, critical access hospitals, rural health clinics and rural federally qualified health centers, including expert analysis, guidance, training opportunities and telehealth investment; to specify the minimum areas of service to be provided by the Center.

HOUSE BILL 326. Signed 06/25/2020. Effective 07/01/2020.

Increases the maximum annual gross sales for a cottage food operation from \$20,000 to \$35,000 to be exempt from food establishment permit fees.

HOUSE BILL 1559. Signed 07/02/2020. Effective 07/02/2020.

An act to authorize the Office of the Attorney General to establish a program to provide counseling, medical needs, transitional housing and other related services to victims of human trafficking and commercial sexual exploitation through shelters and victim service providers established to serve such victims.

HOUSE BILL 1730. Signed 07/02/2020. Effective 07/02/2020.

Increased from \$33,843,000.00 to \$36,843,000.00 the amount of state general obligation bonds authorized to be issued for the Local Government and Rural Water Systems Improvements Revolving Loan Fund.

HOUSE BILL 2626. Signed 06/30/2020. Effective 07/01/2020.

Amends sections 41-99-1, 41-99-3, 41-99-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, to revise the definition of "Service Grant."

SENATE BILL 2725. Signed 06/25/2020. Effective 06/25/2020.

Creates the Mississippi Hemp Cultivation Act to authorize and legalize the cultivation, processing, and transportation of hemp.

SENATE BILL 2674. Signed 07/01/2020. Effective 07/01/2020.

Requires continuing education for community public water system board members and the management training shall be organized by the Department of Health in cooperation with the Mississippi Rural Water Association and other organizations.

SENATE BILL 3056. Signed 10/8/2020. Effective 07/01/2020.

Amend section 41-29-111, Mississippi Code of 1972, to provide that any drug that is scheduled on the federal schedule for the purpose of preventing or treating Covid-19 is automatically scheduled on the corresponding state schedule until the next time the legislature amends the schedule; to amend section 41-29-121, Mississippi Code of 1972, to remove approved Cannabidiol Drugs from Schedule V.







AIDS RATES BY YEAR, UNITED STATES AND MISSISSIPPI, 2008-2018














FISCAL YEAR 2020 EXPENDITURES BY EXPENDITURE CATEGORY


















GENERAL FUND EXPENDITURES
