Annual Report on

Home Health Agencies

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Overview

Fifty-three home health agencies responded to the 2012 survey; 40 free-standing, 9 hospital-based, and 4 health department home health agencies.

Table I shows that 67% of home health agencies reported for-profit status. Approximately 58% of the agencies were controlled by corporations, 15.1% were controlled by local government, 7.6% were controlled by state government, the remaining 18.9% were controlled by local government and other.

Referrals by type of home health agency are shown in Table II. Of the 90,299 total referrals, 76,430 or 84.6% were accepted. Reasons for denied service are shown in Table II. Besides the category 'other', not meeting home health service eligibility was the main reason patients were denied service. Most referrals, 84%, were from physicians and hospitals.

For this report, data from hospital-based home health agencies are shown in tables ending in an A, health department home health agencies are shown in tables ending in a B, free-standing home health agencies are shown in tables ending in a C, and tables ending in a D represent state totals.

Patients Served

There were 88,408 patients served during 2012. This is a non-duplicate count of people. Total number of patients served during 2011 was 86,923.

Table III shows type of services provided by home health agencies. Skilled nursing and home health aides are provided by all home health agencies. Fifty-one agencies provided physical therapy services, forty-eight agencies provided speech/audio services, forty-seven agencies provided social services and occupational therapy services, twenty-seven agencies provided nutrition and three agencies provided respiratory therapy. Appliance/equipment data is no longer being captured.

Table IV shows home health patients served by source of payment. The majority of patients, 76,323 or 71.1% were covered by Medicare, followed by 20,294 or 18.9% by private insurance. Eight thousand seven hundred were covered by Medicaid. The remaining 2,062 patients were covered by self pay or charity.

Table V displays number of patients served by agency during calendar year 2012 by source of payment.

Patients served during calendar year 2012 by type of services provided by county may be found in Table VIII.

Table IX shows home health patients served by Region. Region V served the most patients, 22,438 or 20.9%, followed by Region IX with 15,845 or 14.8% and Region VIII with 13,078 or 12.2%.

Home health patients served during calendar years 1997-2012 by type of service are shown in Table X. Patients served decreased from 99,354 in 1997 to 71,765 in 2002 and increased to 107,379 in 2012. Home health patients served during calendar years 1985 - 2011 may be found in Appendix Table I.

Visits

Table XI displays home health agency visits by source of payment. The majority of visits, 2,316,476 or 71.4%, were paid by Medicare, followed by Medicaid which paid for 557,878 or 17.2%. Private insurance, self pay and charity made up the other 11.4%.

Home health agency visits by agency during calendar year 2012 by source of payment may be found in Table XII.

Home Health Agency visits by agency may be found in Table XIII.

Table XIV shows number of patient visits by type of service. County data is shown in Table XV. Skilled nursing visits accounted for 45% of the 3,242,592 visits. Home health aide visits comprised 27.4% and physical therapy 19.8%. Social services, speech/audio, occupational therapy, nutrition and respiratory therapy services made up the other 248,966 visits.

Table XVI shows home health visits by home health regions. Region V reported the most visits with 661,143, followed by Region IX with 441,437, and Region VIII with 371,194.

Total home health agency visits during calendar years 1997-2012 are shown in Table XVII. Home health agency visits decreased from 7,993,937 in 1997 to 2,788,652 in 2007 and increased to 3,242,592 visits in 2012.

Home health agency admissions by agency by county are reported in Table XVIII.

Total home health agency patient census increased slightly in 2012. Table XIX shows that the beginning census was 32,136 and ending census was 33,636.

Employee data are shown in Table XX. Nurses and aides constitute the largest group of employees, 2,218 or 59% of the total. Home health employees decreased from 4,909 in 2011 to 3,760 in 2012.

There is a list of home health agencies by classification by county in Appendix B. Counties served by each agency are indicated.

A copy of the survey instrument and instructions may be found in Appendix C.

Definitions

Branch Office shall mean a location or site from which a home health agency provides services within a portion of the total geographic area served by the parent agency. The branch office is part of the home health agency and is located sufficiently close (within a fifty (50) mile radius) to share administration, supervision and services in a manner that renders it unnecessary to obtain a separate license as a home health agency. A branch office shall be staffed with at least one (1) registered nurse on a full-time basis.

Directly shall mean providing home health services through salaried employees of the home health agency or through personnel under hourly or per visit contracts or the equivalent. Where an hourly or per visit contract is made, Part V Section H must be followed to ensure adequate control and supervision by the home health agency.

Geographic Area shall mean the land area, for which the agency shall be licensed, consisting of not more than a fifty (50) mile radius surrounding the home health agency's office location. The geographic area shall be expressed in Mississippi counties.

Home Health Agency shall mean a public or privately owned agency or organization, or a subdivision of such an agency or organization, properly authorized to conduct business in Mississippi, which is primarily engaged in providing to individuals at the written direction of a licensed physician, in the individual's place of residence, skilled nursing services provided by or under the supervision of a Registered Nurse licensed to practice in Mississippi, and one or more of the following part-time or intermittent services or items:

- a. physical, occupational or speech therapy
- b. medical social services
- c. home health aide services
- d. other services as approved by the licensing agency
- e. medical supplies, other than drugs and biologicals, and the use of medical appliances
- f. medical services provided by a resident in training at a hospital under a teaching program of such hospital.

Parent Home Health Agency shall mean the agency that develops and maintains administrative control of sub-units and/or branches.

Patient's Residence shall mean the place where the patient makes his home, such as his own apartment or house, a relative's home but shall not include a hospital, nursing home or other extended care

facility with the exception of services provided through outpatient therapy in a nursing home.

Skilled Nursing Services shall mean patient care services pertaining to the curative, restorative, and preventive aspects of nursing performed by or under the supervision of a registered nurse pursuant to the plan of treatment established in consultation with

appropriate members of the care team. Skilled nursing service is nursing care emphasizing a high level of nursing direction, observation and skill.

Sub-Unit shall mean a semi-autonomous organization which serves patients in a geographic area different from that of the parent agency. A sub-unit shall be licensed separately from the parent agency and shall not have a branch office.

General: Please supply current data on name, address and organizational information requested.

SECTION A: Referrals

A referral is any person for which home health services were sought and for which a determination was made to admit or not to admit for services.

Referrals may be received from any source. This does $\underline{\text{not}}$ mean only those certified for services by a physician.

Total number of people served during calendar year 2012, is a request for a non-duplicate count of the number of people, <u>not</u> admissions, served. If a person was admitted for services on more than one occasion during the calendar year that should still be counted as one person in answering this question.

SECTION B: Census

List in alphabetical order, all counties in which the Agency provided home health services. Then enter in the appropriate columns the patient census as of midnight 12/31/11, all admissions during calendar year 2012 all discharges during calendar year 2012, and the patient census as of midnight 12/31/12. Total each column on the bottom line.

NOTE: A person may have more that one admission and/or discharges during a calendar year. In such cases each admission must be counted independently. Patient census as of midnight 12/31/11 should correspond with census reported for 12/31/11 on last year's (2011) report.

SECTION C: Services Provided

Check all services provided to patients during calendar year 2012 which meet the definitions in the <u>Minimum Standards of Operation for Mississippi Home Health Agencies.</u>

SECTION D: Patients Served

Record, by county, all patients served during the 2012 calendar year under the appropriate service. A patient may be recorded in more than one row, depending on the number of services provided that

patient. A person may be counted as a patient more than once, if that person was admitted for service on more than one occasion. Note:

Total patients served on page 3 should match total of patients served by source of payment on page 4.

SECTION E: Visits Conducted

Record, by county, the number of visits rendered within each service. Total both rows and columns. Note: visits reported on page 3 should match visits by source of payment on page 4.

SECTION F: Cost/Charges/Source of Payment

For each service provided list per visit the cost, as reported on your most recent Medicaid/Medicare Cost Report specifying FY, and your customary charges.

Report number of visits within each service by source of payment and the number of patients served by source of payment.

NOTE: Total of number of patients by source of payment should equal total of row (i) in SECTION D.

SECTION G: Uncompensated Services

Record the number of patients and the number of visits by service for which you received no reimbursement.

SECTION H: Employees

List the number of employees in the appropriate column as of 12/31/12. The column labeled "Under Arrangement" refers to personnel provided through contract with other agencies or organizations.

Individuals under contract should be listed under the "Full-Time" or "Part-Time" columns.

Signatures: The report should be signed by the responsible person and the agency's administrator. The responsible person is the individual, whose name appeared on the agency's license.

Maintain a photo-copy of your completed 2012 Annual Report for your records. It will be necessary to refer to the 2012 report in completing next year's Annual Report.
