### **Liver Cancer**

#### Risk factors

- · Being overweight
- Having a long-term Hepatitis B virus or Hepatitis C virus infection
- Smoking
- Drinking alcohol
- · Having scarring of the liver
- · Having nonalcoholic fatty liver disease
- · Being diabetic

#### Symptoms

- Discomfort in the upper abdomen on the right side
- A swollen abdomen
- A hard lump on the right side just below the rib cage
- Pain near the right shoulder blade or in the back
- · Yellowing of the skin and whites of the eyes
- · Easy bruising or bleeding
- Unusual tiredness
- Nausea and vomiting
- · Loss of appetite
- · Weight loss for no known reason

## Who should be screened?

- Get vaccinated against Hepatitis B.
   The Hepatitis B vaccine is recommended for all infants at birth and for adults who may be at increased risk.
- Get tested for Hepatitis C, and get medical care if you have it.
