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Preface

Skilled Nursing Facilities

Overvi ew

Magnolia Manor Nursing Home

One-hundred seventy-nine licensed skilled nursing facilities, 13 intermediate care facilities for the mentally retarded, 5 psychiatric residential treatment facilities and 174 licensed personal care homes responded to the 1998 survey. The data in this report is based upon the information supplied by these respondents.

Twenty-one nursing facilities changed names during the reporting period.

Map I shows that 79 counties are served by nursing care homes. This coverage represents 96.3% of all 82 Mississippi counties leaving 3.7% or 3 counties without nursing home facilities of some type. These counties are: Amite, Carroll, and Issaguena.

Since 1981, personal care home data has been shown and discussed separately to give a clearer picture of nursing care homes in Mississippi. Also, the classification of nursing homes was changed in 1981 making comparisons of data collected before and after 1981 difficult. Nursing home classifications changed again in 1989. Now nursing homes are either licensed as skilled nursing facilities, intermediate/care facilities for the mentally retarded, or psychiatric residential treatment facilities.

In order to more accurately reflect data for current and subsequent years, Table I for years 1961-1994 is a separate table found in Appendix B. There were 17,376 skilled nursing facility beds. This figure represents an increase of 41 beds from the previous year. Crawford Nursing Home, a 71 bed facility is not licensed at this time and is not included in the total.

The total patient census on December 31, 1997, was 16,508. This represents a statewide skilled nursing facility occupancy rate of 94.6%. The patient count also represents an average of 92.2 patients per nursing home.

The total number of patients served during the year, 27,798, was an increase of 587 from 1997. New admissions to nursing homes increased by 323 patients.

Ownershi p

Table II shows that 119 or 66.5% of the nursing homes had proprietary ownership and accounted for 67.5% of all licensed nursing home beds. In contrast, nonprofit nursing homes accounted for 29 or 16.2% of all nursing homes and 13.5% of the licensed nursing home beds. The remaining 31 or 17.3% of nursing homes were publicly owned and leased with 19% of the licensed nursing home beds.

Empl oyees

Table III shows that 18,271 people were employed in Skilled Nursing Facilities in Mississippi in 1998. Full-time employees were 14,719 or 80.6% of this number while 3,552 or 19.4% were part-time employees. Nursing service employees including R.N.s, L.P.N.s, Aides, and Orderlies accounted for 11,822 or 64.7% of the total number of employees.

Beds

Table IV lists the 179 skilled nursing facilities in alphabetical order, showing that all but 43 of the 17,376 licensed nursing home beds are set up and staffed. County of location is also shown.

Table V shows a state skilled nursing facility occupancy rate of 94.6%, and an average daily census of 16,445.2. One skilled nursing facility had occupancy rates of 100%, 110 homes had occupancy rates between 96% and 99%, 43 homes had occupancy rates between 90 and 95%, 24 homes had an occupancy rate of 89 or less, and one facility just had a couple of patients during the year, and therefore no rates were calculated. Occupancy rates are calculated on licensed beds, therefore occupancy rates calculated on beds set up and staffed would be higher. Because of bed changes and the opening of four nursing facilities, the state occupancy rate shown represents an average.

Tables VI gives a breakdown by county of the number of licensed nursing home beds and the type of accommodation available by number of beds set up and staffed. The county having the most Skilled Nursing Facility beds was Hinds, with 1,392 beds licensed and 1,391 set up and staffed for use.

Table VII shows that there were 17,376 licensed nursing care beds in Mississippi, an increase of 41 beds over 1997. Semi-private rooms accounted for 13,528 or 78% of the beds set up and staffed; private rooms accounted for 2,354 or 13.6% and wards accounted for 1,451 or 8.4%.

Table VIII shows that 89 or 49.7% of all nursing care facilities had between 60 and 119 beds, 60 facilities or 33.5% had between 120-179 beds, 18 facilities or 10% had less than 60 beds, 11 or 5.6% had between 180 and 239, and two facilities had more than 240 beds. Map II gives a pictorial view of the distribution of Skilled Nursing Facilities by bed size and county and Table IX shows the bed count groups by county.

Patient Characteristics

Table X shows that there were 27,798 patients served by the 179 nursing homes in Mississippi during 1998, for an average of 155 patients served per facility. There was an increase of 587 patients reported served in 1998 than 1997. There were 21,498 patients, age 75 years and older, accounting for 77.3% of all patients served. Females comprised 19,769 or 71.1% of the patients served during 1998.

Beginning and ending patient census by sex are shown in Table XI. On December 31, 1998 there were 16,508 patients in skilled nursing facilities.

Total patient days are shown in Table XII along with the ambulation status of nursing home patients. During 1998 nursing homes reported 5,991,645 patient days, a slight increase from 5,967,856 patient days reported in 1997. Approximately 47% skilled nursing facility patients were ambulant.

New Admissions

Table XIII indicates that 11,280 new patients were admitted in 1998, for an average of 63 new admissions per facility. New admissions increased by 323. Admissions from hospitals accounted for 7,576 or 67%; admissions from own or relatives home accounted for 1,779 or 15.8; admissions from another nursing home accounted for 1,232 or 10.9% and the remaining 693 or 6.1% were admitted from other places.

Source of Payments

Table XIV reveals the fee sources for the 11,280 new admissions in 1998. The combined 9,423 Medicare and Medicaid funded patients were 83.5% of all fee sources and represented a reported increase of 323 patients. One thousand four hundred fifty five or 12.9%, of admissions were self-pay. VA sponsored admissions were 268 or 2.4% of fee sources. Other sources of pay accounted for 1.2 percent of the total.

Discharges and Deaths

Table XV shows that live discharges accounted for 67.9% of patients discharge from nursing homes. The majority of these were to hospitals 41.4%, or homes 32.4% Approximately seventeen percent were transferred to another nursing facility, and the remaining 8.8% were discharged to other locations.

Table XVI displays total patient days, total admissions and total patients served by county for skilled nursing facilities.

Intermediate Care Facilities for the Mentally Retarded

Map III shows the Location of the 13 LCF/MRs. Jones County has the most LCF/MRs with 4, followed by Simpson County with 2, Coahoma County, Harrison County, Lafayette County, Lincoln County, Madison County, Oktibbeha County and Rankin County with 1 each.

ICF/MR licensed beds increased from 2,409 in 1997 to 2,480 in 1998. Approximately 27% of ICF/MR beds are located in Jones County.

The total patient census on December 31, 1998, was 2,409. This represents an ICF-MR occupancy rate of 94.7%. The patient count also represents an average of 185.3 patients per facility.

The total number of patients served during the year, 2,665 was an increase of 110 from 1997. New admissions to nursing homes decreased by 185 patients.

Ownershi p

Table XVIII shows that 7 or 53.8% of the ICF/MRs were publicly owned and accounted for approximately 60% of all licensed ICF/MR beds. Proprietary ownershi accounted for 5 or 38% of the homes. The remaining 355 beds were non-profit.

Empl oyees

Employees at ICF/MRs are depicted in Table XIX. In 1998 3,982 people were employed at ICF/MR facilities. Approximately 94% of the employees are full-time. Nursing service employees including R. N. s, L. P. N. s, Aides, and Orderlies accounted for 2,336 or 58.7% of the total number of employees.

Beds

Table XX lists the 13 nursing homes in alphabetical order, showing that all but 54 of the 2,497 licensed nursing home beds are set up and staffed. County of location is also shown.

Licensed beds, occupancy rates and average daily census are shown by county in Table XXI. Occupancy rates are calculated on licensed beds, therefore occupancy rates calculated on beds set up and staffed would be higher.

The state ICF-MR occupancy was 95.3% and the average daily census was 2,363.6. All but one facility had occupancy rates 95% or higher.

Table XXII gives a breakdown by county of the number of licensed nursing home beds and the type of accommodation available by number of beds set up and staffed. The county having the most ICF/MR beds was Jones, with 651 beds licensed, followed by Lafayette County with 389 beds, Rankin County with 355, Simpson with 308 beds, Harrison with 240, Lincoln with 140 and Coahoma, Madison ar Oktibbeha with 132 each.

Table XXIII shows that there were 2,480 licensed ICF/MR beds in Mississippi. Semi-private rooms accounted for 1,390 or 56.9% of the beds set up and staffed; wards accounted for 983 or 40.2%; and private rooms accounted for 70 or 2.9%.

Map IV gives a pictorial view of the distribution of ICF/MRs by bed size and county. Table XXIV shows that 6 or 46.2% of all nursing care facilities had between 120 and 179 beds, 4 facilities had more than 240 beds, 1 or 7.7% had between 180 and 239, and 2 had between 60-119 or 15.4%. A county listing of licensed beds by type is depicted in Table XXV.

Patient Characteristics

Table XXVI shows that there were 2,665 patients served by the 13 ICF/MRs in Mississippi during 1998, for an average of 205 patients served per facility. There was a slight decrease of patients reported served in 1998 than 1997.

Approximately 66% of ICF/MR patients were under 45 years of age, 27.4% were aged 4 to 64, and 6.9% were aged 65 and older. Males made up 57.4% of the ICF/MR population.

Beginning and ending patient census by sex are shown in Table XXVII. On December 31, 1997 there were 2,336 patients in ICF/MRs, and on December 31, 1998 there were 2,409 patients in ICF/MRs.

Total patient days by classification are shown in Table XXVIII along with the ambulation status of ICF/MR patients. During 1998 ICF/MRs reported 862,708 patient days, a slight increase from 834,604 patient days reported in 1997. Approximately 79% ICF/MR patients were ambulant.

New Admissions

Table XXIX indicates that 329 new patients were admitted in 1998, for an average of 25 new admissions per facility. New admissions decreased by 185. Admissions from home or relatives home accounted for 197 or 59.9% of all new admissions, 15 or 4.6% were admitted from hospitals, 71 or 21.6% were admitted from other nursing homes. The remaining 46 admissions, 13.9%, were admitted from other places.

Source of Payments

Table XXX reveals the fee sources for the 329 new admissions in 1998. Approximately 91% were Medicaid admissions. The remaining 9.1% came from Medicare, patients and/or relatives and other sources.

Discharges and Deaths

Live discharges decreased while deaths increased slightly from 1997's statistics. Total number of live discharges and deaths shown in Table XXXI. ICF/MR live discharges accounted for 84.8%. The majority of live discharges, 48.4 were to homes, 7.4% were discharged to hospitals, 30.9% were transferred to another nursing home, and 13.4% were discharged to other places.

Table XXXII displays total patient days, total admissions and total patients served by county for ICF/MRs.

Psychiatric Residential Treatment Facilities

 $\mbox{\it Map V}$ shows the location of the 5 psychiatric residential treatment facilities.

Total patient census on December 31, 1998 was 160. This represents an increase over 1997.

Ownershi p

Table XXXIV shows that 60% of the 196 beds were proprietary and 40% were nonprofit.

Empl oyees

Employees at psychiatric residential treatment facilities are depicted in Table XXXV. In 1998 413 people were employed, of which 69% were full-time. Nursing service employees including R.N.s, L.P.N.s, Aides and Orderlies accounted for 233 or 56.1% of the total number of employees.

Beds

Table XXXVI shows that all 196 licensed beds are set up and staffed.

Licensed beds, occupancy rates and average daily census are shown by county in Table XXXVII. The state psychiatric residential treatment facility occupancy rate was 81.7% and average daily census was 160.5.

Table XXXVIII gives a breakdown by county of the number of licensed psychiatric residential treatment facility beds and the type of accommodation available by number of beds set up and staffed.

Table XXXIX shows that there were 196 licensed psychiatric residential treatment facility beds in Mississippi. Semi-private rooms accounted for 154 or 78.6% of the beds set up and staffed, wards accounted for 40 or 20.4%, and private rooms accounted for 2 or 1%.

Patient Characteristics

Table XL shows that there were 527 patients served by the 5 facilities. All except 3 patients were under 18.

Beginning and ending patient census by sex are shown in Table XLI. On December 31, 1997 there were 136 patients in psychiatric residential treatment facilities and on December 31, 1998 there were 160 patients.

Total patient days are shown in Table XLII along with ambulation status. There were 58,569 patient days reported in 1998 and all 160 patients were ambulant.

New Admissions

Of the 391 new patients admitted during 1998, 37.3% were admitted from hospitals, 28.6% were admitted from home, 10.5% were admitted from another nursing home and the remaining 23.5% were admitted from other places.

Source of Payments

Table XLIV reveals that 391, 89.5%, new admissions during 1998 were admitted under Medicaid. The remaining 10.5% were admitted by patients and/or relatives and other sources.

Discharges and Deaths

Of the 367 discharges, 61.3% returned home, 30.5% transferred to other places, 3.5% transferred to another nursing home and the remaining 4.6% was discharged to hospitals.

Table XLVI displays total patient days, total admissions and total patients served by county.

Personal Care Homes

One hundred seventy-four personal care homes responded to the survey, which represents an increase of 15 over those responding in 1997. Map VI shows the distribution by county of licensed personal care homes. The following 28 personal care homes opened during 1998.







Distribution of Nursing Facilities by Bed Size and County as of December 31, 1998







Map IV **Distribution of ICF/MRs by Bed Size and County as of December 31, 1998**







Psychiatric Residential Facilities by Type of Ownership



Map VI **Distribution of Personal Care Homes by County**as of December 31, 1998





Distribution of Personal Care Homes by Bed Size and County as of December 31, 1998



The information to be entered on Page 1 is mostly self-explanatory with the possible exception of the section regarding "Number of employees as of December 31, 1998." Only those workers who are employees of the institution and are paid by the institution should be shown. A full-time employee is one who works approximately forty (40) hours per week in the institution. A consultant should be counted as part-time.

In reporting the number of employees for the distinct parts - report only those employees that staff the distinct part.

PAGE 2

SECTION A. Number of patients by race and sex.

- Line 1. Enter number of patients in the facility at midnight on date shown. Enter race and sex in appropriate column. The entries on Line 1 must correspond with Line 5 of the 1997 report.
