Pandemic Flu Preparation:

WHAT CAN SCHOOLS DO?

Teach students the importance of hand washing and how to wash their hands properly.
Allow regular breaks for the students and teachers to wash their hands.
Help young children wash their hands properly.
Clean surfaces such as door handles, handrails, eating surfaces and desks frequently with disinfectant.
Check restrooms regularly to ensure soap and paper towels are always available.
Keep tissues and trash cans in all classrooms.
Plan ways to keep students up to date with school work if they are home ill or school is closed.
