RESOLUTION OF MISSISSIPPI STATE BOARD OF HEALTH APPOINTING INTERIM STATE HEALTH OFFICER

Whereas, the State Board of Health is authorized by Section 41-3-5.1 of the <u>Mississippi</u> <u>Code of 1972</u>, <u>Annotated</u>, as amended, to appoint an executive officer who "...shall be...a physician who in the opinion of the board is fitted and equipped to execute the duties incumbent upon him or her by law..." and who shall be the State Health Officer with the such authority and responsibility has prescribed by law; and

Whereas, the State Board of Health at its October 21, 2009 regular meeting approved a business continuity plan for seamless operation and function of the Mississippi State Department of Health;

Be it Resolved, the State Board Health unanimously approves the appointment of Mary Currier, MD, MPH as Interim State Health Officer effective December 1, 2009 with full authority as provided in law to the State Health Officer position and until such time as the Board takes further action to appoint a permanent State Health Officer.
