


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



CHANGES IN REGULATIONS

The following final regulatory actions were taken by the Mississippi State Board of Health in FY 2012:

JULY 13, 2011

Final Adoption of changes made to the Minimum Standards of Operation for Ambulatory Surgical Facilities.

—This change requires reappointment of each medical staff member every three years as opposed to every two years.

Final Adoption of changes made to the Minimum Standards for Institutions for the Aged or Infirm.

—The "Duty to Report" section has been modified to clarify the reporting requirement when incidences such as fire, explosion and natural disasters and/or injury from such incidences occur in a licensed entity. This change also specifies a central location for the collection of such reports.

Final Adoption of changes made to the Minimum Standards for Personal Care Homes—Assisted Living.

—The "Duty to Report" section has been modified to clarify the reporting requirement when incidences such as fire, explosion and natural disasters and/or injury from such incidences occur in a licensed entity. This change also specifies a central location for the collection of such reports.

Final Adoption of changes made to the Minimum Standards for Personal Care Homes—Residential Living.

—The "Duty to Report" section has been modified to clarify the reporting requirement when incidences such as fire, explosion and natural disasters and/or injury from such incidences occur in a licensed entity. This change also specifies a central location for the collection of such reports.

Final Adoption of changes made to the Minimum Standards for Adult Foster Care Facilities.

—The "Duty to Report" section has been modified to clarify the reporting requirement when incidences such as fire, explosion and natural disasters and/or injury from such incidences occur in a licensed entity. This change also specifies a central location for the collection of such reports.

Final Adoption of the CON Review Manual, Effective September 1, 2011.

Final Adoption of the FY 2012 Mississippi State Health Plan.

OCTOBER 12, 2011

Final Adoption of the Mississippi Qualified Health Center (MQHC) Grant Program Rules and Regulations Manual.

JANUARY 11, 2012

The Board took no final regulatory action during the January 11, 2012 Board Meeting.

APRIL 11, 2012

Final Adoption of changes made to the Mississippi Conrad State 30 J-1 Visa Waiver Guidelines.

—The change allows for the Department to use its discretionary authority to accept more than two site predetermination applications per employer each federal fiscal year. Prior to this change, the Department was prohibited from accepting more than two applications from any one employer during each federal fiscal year.

CHANGES IN STATE LAW

Legislative Update for the 2012 Mississippi Legislative Session:

SENATE BILL 2526

- —Revises § 73-65-1 § 73-65-15, Mississippi Code of 1972, to reflect changes in the national organization that provides credentialing and educational requirements for Professional Art Therapists. This change provides for a consumer member to serve as part of the advisory council. The change further allows the correction and deletion of "grandfathering" clauses no longer applicable to the licensure of the profession.
- —This bill was **proposed** by the Mississippi State Board of Health.

SENATE BILL 2527

- —Revises § 73-57-1 § 73-57-39, Mississippi Code of 1972, to reflect changes in the credentialing and practice of respiratory care. This change allows council members to be appointed from the state-at-large. This change deletes language not applicable to the practice of Respiratory Care Practitioners in Mississippi and provides clarification of items to reflect current practice.
- —This bill was **proposed** by the Mississippi State Board of Health.

HOUSE BILL 730

- —Adds 5methoxy-N,N-dimethyltryptamine (5-MeO-DMT) including its salts, isomers and salts of isomers whenever the existence of such salts, isomers, and salts of isomers is possible to Schedule 1 (C) "hallucinogenic substances" of the Controlled Substance Act.
- —This bill was **proposed** by the Mississippi State Board of Health.

SENATE BILL 2670

- —Creates the "Patient's Right to Informed Health Care Choices Act." Amends sections 73-9-61, 73-21-97, 73-25-29, 73-26-5, 73-27-13, 73-15-29, 73-19-23, 73-6-19 and 73-39-77, Mississippi Code of 1972, to regulate and provide standards for health care practitioners' advertisement practices and communications. This change provides that violations of deceptive advertisement by health care practitioners are specific grounds for disciplinary action against licensees.
- —This bill was **endorsed** by the Mississippi State Board of Health.


HOUSE BILL 540

- —Authorizes local school boards to allow school property to be used by the public during nonschool hours for recreation and sports and limits the liability of school districts and school district employees for claims arising from the public's use of school property and facilities for recreation and sports. Encourages school districts to enter into shared use agreements with community organizations and local governmental entities for purposes of recreation and sports. Requires the State Department of Education, in consultation with the State Department of Health, to develop a best practices tool kit relating to shared use agreements.
- —This bill was **endorsed** by the Mississippi State Board of Health.

SENATE BILL 2851

- —Amends section 93-1-5, Mississippi Code of 1972, to eliminate the three-day waiting period for a marriage license and to delete the requirement for a blood test for syphilis.
- —This bill was neither proposed nor endorsed by the Mississippi State Department of Health; however, it has significant implications for the Department of Health and therefore its inclusion in this report is appropriate.



AIDS RATES BY YEAR, UNITED STATES AND MISSISSIPPI, 2001-2010









TUBERCULOSIS RATES BY YEAR, UNITED STATES AND MISSISSIPPI, 2002-2011

VACCINATION COVERAGE AMONG CHILDREN 19-35 MONTHS, BY YEAR, MISSISSIPPI AND UNITED STATES







WEBSITE: TOTAL DOCUMENTS DOWNLOADED




WEBSITE: TOTAL PAGE VIEWS

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
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
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
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FISCAL YEAR 2012 EXPENDITURES BY MAJOR CATEGORY
